TOPICS COVERED

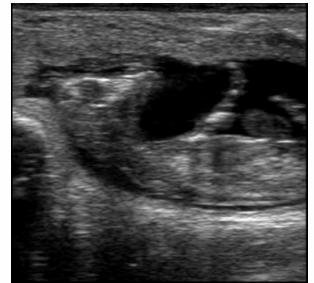
- Female reproductive tract evaluation

COURSE STRUCTURE

This 2-day course for veterinarians is divided into in-class lectures and hands-on training. The in-class portion will give attendees the knowledge required to perform reproductive ultrasound evaluations in cattle, whereas the hands-on experiential learning (the majority of the course) will allow attendees to extensively practice ultrasound examinations.
