12/4/25 (Thursday)	<ul> <li>Heifers are received.</li> <li>TSU's are taken for testing for Persistently Infected - BVD.</li> <li>Heifers are dewormed and given an intranasal vaccine.</li> <li>Record weights and disposition scores.</li> </ul>
1/7/26	<ul> <li>Weights and hip heights are recorded.</li> <li>Booster vaccinations for Respiratory &amp; Reproductive vaccines as well as 7-way Clostridial.</li> <li>Report 1</li> </ul>
1/28/26	<ul> <li>Reproductive tract scores, weights, pelvic areas, and disposition scores are collected. CIDRs are inserted.</li> <li>Report 2</li> </ul>
2/11/26	CIDRs are removed.
2/27/26	<ul> <li>Give 5 ml of Lutalyse (Give shot between 2-5 p.m.).</li> <li>Apply heat detection patches.</li> <li>Record weights.</li> </ul>
3/2/26	<ul> <li>Time breed all heifers (7-11am)</li> <li>GNRH is administered.</li> <li>Report 3</li> </ul>
Prior to 3/2/26	Breeding soundness exams should be conducted on the cleanup bulls.
3/9/26	Clean-up bulls turned out with the heifers.
4/1/26	<ul> <li>Heifers are weighed, measured for hip heights, given disposition scores, and graded by three different individuals; blood is pulled to determine which heifers settled AI.</li> <li>Report 4</li> </ul>
4/23/26	• Cleanup bulls are removed - 45 days with the heifers (3/9/26 - 4/23/26 = 52 days from start of AI to bull removal)
5/20/26	<ul> <li>Final ultrasound check on the heifers. (27 days after bull removal) Sort out of chute into Sale and Non-Sale Groups. Check EIDs. Apply fly control.</li> </ul>
5/26/26	Move heifers to sale facility and sort into sale pens.
