Enclosed are the rules and nomination form for the 2026-27 Georgia Bull Evaluation Programs at Calhoun and Tifton. Please be sure to read over the rules very carefully.

A few other friendly reminders for entry and rules updates:

- You must send a \$50 nomination fee per bull along with the entry form.
- **The deadline for nominations in Calhoun is June 1, 2026. Tifton is September 1st, 2026.**
- Both nomination /entry deadlines for Calhoun and Tifton are postmark dates.
- **Please remember:** Health papers for in-state bulls are not necessary. However, bulls must be in good health. Bulls carrying ringworm and/or warts need to be treated and healing prior to delivery. Please contact station management to discuss any issues.
- Per the rules upon delivery: bring a fully completed delivery form (mailed to you upon acceptance of entry), vaccination form, and the original signed registration paper. For Angus bulls, please store their registrations electronically and bring a printed copy of their online registration on delivery day.
- Please submit all performance data, parentage and genomic sample info necessary to your respective breed association in plenty of time so that this will not be delayed.
- At time of delivery, 2/3 of the total test fee will be due. Consignors will be invoiced at the 56 day weigh period for the remaining 1/3 if not paid in full on delivery day.
- All bulls must have official adjusted 205-day weights. This means that you will have to participate in your breed associations performance records program.
- It is essential that you follow the pre-condition program laid out in the rules.
- If feasible, it is ideal for producers to have their GE-EPDs in hand when making decisions about which bulls to consign particularly for calving ease associated traits.
